It was interesting to see so many people who came over to our store just to identify with us as well as those who did not care who we were, but still came to our store. All the same, we fed everybody without any discrimination.

This is the second time we have been to Bunnings Capalaba for a BBQ which is one of the ideal of our last Parish Planning Day. Both occasions have been very successful and we do not intend to stop. All the same, we will not mind going to any other store or business that allows similar outings for the sake of reaching out to as many people as possible. 
