HOLY WEEK CEREMONIES 2018

The celebration of Palm Sunday or Passion Sunday this weekend welcomes us to this year's **Holy Week** ceremonies. We will read the shorter form of the Passion Narrative at our Masses this Saturday and the longer one on Sunday. Each version will make the Masses a bit longer than usual but they will also elaborate on the richness of our redemption through Christ. This will likely be the case as we liturgically journey through the **Easter Triduum** before reaching our sacramental climax on Easter Sunday.

On **Holy Thursday** the liturgy will begin with the Mass of the Lord's Supper at St Anthony's at 7.30pm. This will be followed by the Adoration of the Holy Eucharist to enable us to keep awake with our Lord. This year's adoration will be mainly in the form of private prayers. Any group or family that wishes to recite the Holy Rosary or say any other prayer should kindly let us know. We also encourage parishioners to please indicate their preferred time for adoration on the lists in the gathering spaces of each of our churches.

On **Good Friday** we will still begin at the Uniting Church, Ney Road, Capalaba by joining our sister church in prayer at 8.30am. At the end of which, we will mark the Stations of the Cross along Ney Road and Degen Road and end at St Luke's Church. We seriously encourage our parishioners to actively participate in the Stations of the Cross as small number of people doing this is not good witnessing to our faith. At 3.00pm, the members of the Uniting Church will be joining us for our Good Friday Liturgy at St Luke's Capalaba.

On **Holy Saturday** we will begin our Vigil Mass at 6.00pm at St Anthony's. Our RCIA candidate, Roger Norman will be formally received and Confirmed during the mass. This Mass is usually longer than any other. We also encourage everyone to use this opportunity to invite their family members and friends to worship with us during this holy season. We wish everyone a spirit and faith filled Holy Week.
