INTRODUCING “PROCLAIM 2018” CONFERENCE

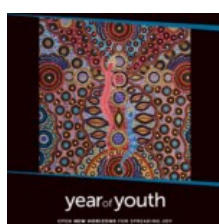
There are a number of important programs in both the Archdiocese and the Catholic Church at the national level that are still in the planning stages but may become prioritized very soon. These programs are quite important and we feel that it is necessary that everyone begins now to get to know about them. If it is possible, every Catholic needs to get involved with them and even participate actively in them. Among them is the “Proclaim 2018” Conference.

Proclaim 2018 Conference is a program of the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference’s National Centre for Evangelisation. It is fashioned to lead parishes and faith communities into conversation on five key areas of the church’s life today, namely, **Leadership, Culture Change, Young People, Belonging and Evangelisation**. This is the first time the conference will be held in Brisbane and the theme of this year is “*Make your home in me*” (Jn. 15:4). The venue for the conference is The Edmund Rice Performing Arts Centre (St Laurence’s College, South Brisbane) and it will go between 12th and 14th July, 2018. The key speaker at the conference will include Cardinal John Dew of New Zealand and Archbishop Mark Coleridge of Brisbane, among others.

Our Parish will offset the cost of any five parishioners who are willing to participate in this program as long as they are willing to enrich our parish with the knowledge and skills they acquire from the conference. All those who are already involved in various ministries in the parish and potential members of either Pastoral/Stewardship or Finance Councils are encouraged to consider participating in this program. Year of Youth Retreat Days

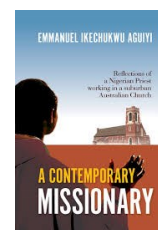
