A NUMBER OF APPEALS WITHIN THE MID YEAR

As we already know the number of appeals at masses significantly reduced when the Archdiocese introduced the Annual Catholic Campaign a few years ago. With this, the four big appeals of the Archdiocese compressed into one. However, appeals from various Catholic agencies and charities, such as St Vincent de Paul, Caritas Australia, Catholic Mission and Sea Fearers', among others remain. So too have Universal Church appeals such as Peter's Pence, the Holy Land Appeal and Mission Appeals. Our deanery also has her annual food appeal which involves all Catholic Churches and Catholic Primary Schools across our deanery.

These appeals unfortunately tend to come up around this time of the year mainly because of the end of the financial year and the tax benefits that go with it. 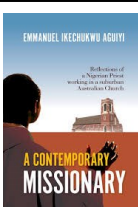
