


**A Stewardship Moment: "Get up and eat, else the journey will be too long for you!" Kings 19:7**

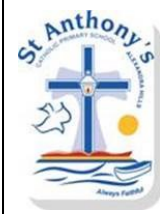

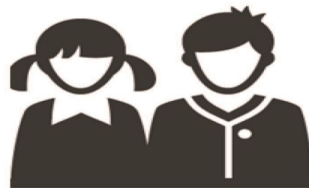
