The Gift of Faith in Us

These days, people generally tend to get along irrespective of their varying faith inclination. However, sometimes we might come across some people who may not be comfortable with us because of our faith. They could be people without faith or people who belong to a different faith that does not necessarily agree with ours. Surprisingly, they might at times be people who belong to the same faith as us but feel that we are either a bit too much over the top or in some cases, too weak. In such moments, varying ranges of emotions could develop within us. Whatever the situation, we need to handle it with care and love.

Such situations could be opportunities for us to positively bear witness to our faith. So do not allow it to either annoy you or make you speak in an unfriendly manner. Similarly, we should not within such a situation compromise or deny our faith by watering it down to give a wrong impression that it is not really that important to us. A simple thing like maintaining a gentle silence without betraying our faith at such moments could convince another about the grace of faith in our heart. We are not bound to justify or prove our faith to anyone. At the same time, if one wants, he or she can explain the faith to someone who is willing to learn.

Our faith is God's precious gift that connects us to Him. People of faith have humbly accepted this generous gift. We should be proud of it. It is an essential feature of who we are. No one has the right to judge the nature, strength or quality of our faith. Only God can.
