Dear Children,

There are only sixteen days left for that great celebration! Wow...! Are you ready for Christmas? I know you hear this question quite often these days. What do people mean by this question? Well, basically they are asking you I...Are you done with your shopping? Have you packed your Christmas gifts? Is your Christmas tree decorated and ready? Have you sent your Christmas cards? There is another question that is much more important than "Are you ready for Christmas?" That question is, "Are you ready for Christ?" Dear children, you need to pray to Jesus to make your heart a beautiful crib of love where he can come and stay. Let's ask him to do that right now.

So let us pray, dear Jesus, prepare my heart suitable for you, come and stay with me and never depart from me.
