

A Thought from Fr Emmanuel

Our Lady of Lourdes - World Day of the Sick



February 11 is **World Day of the Sick**, an observation started by St. Pope John Paul II as a way for believers to offer prayers for those suffering from illnesses. The day coincides with the commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes. People around the world take the time to pray for the sick and for those who work very hard to alleviate the sufferings of the sick on this day.

Christ came to eliminate suffering. He came to give fullness of life, both natural and supernatural. It is true that his main purpose was to give supernatural life, but he intends us to enjoy fullness of natural life also. When he was on earth he cured the sick and sent his Apostles out to do the same in his name.

Anointing of the sick is a Sacrament of Faith - faith in the minister of the sacrament and faith for the one who receives it. The core of the Sacramental celebration consists of the Priest's Prayer and the Anointing. The formula used, in keeping with the promise made by Christ through St James in his Apostolic letter, stresses not only prayers for a sick person's forgiveness but also for 'raising up' and salvation.

'Through this holy anointing may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the Grace of the Holy Spirit. Amen.'

'May the Lord, who frees you from sin, save you and raise you up. Amen.'

Thus is expressed the care of Christ and the Church for sick people. Christ is working again through the Sacrament with his sympathy and healing, as he did when he was on earth.

The fifth chapter of St James' letter describes the sacrament:

'Is any among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the Church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer of faith will save the sick man, and the Lord will raise him up; and if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven' (James 5, 14-15).

Dear Parishioners, in the light of the above reflection we have an **Anointing Mass on Monday, 11**th **February at 5 pm at St. Anthony's Church.** You are most welcome to attend the service and to experience the healing touch of Jesus.
