ARCHBISHOP MARK COLERIDGE'S

STATEMENT ON THE TERROR ATTACKS IN CHRISTCHURCH, 16 MARCH 2019

The Catholic Church in Australia was deeply shocked by the evil visited upon the Muslim people of Christchurch yesterday as they came to worship. Beyond Christchurch and New Zealand, the blood flowed right around the world; the entire human family has been grievously wounded by this violence.

The Archdiocese of Brisbane wishes first to express our solidarity with the Muslim community in Christchurch and New Zealand. We wish also to assure the Muslim people of Australia that we stand with you in this time of tribulation. You are not "the other"; you are part of us and we are part of you; you are our brothers and sisters. Therefore, we share your pain and offer our prayers as we turn with you to God.

We and our people pray for the many dead and for their families: may they know the peace of heaven. We pray for the wounded: may God protect and heal them. We pray even for those responsible for this atrocity: may they know the justice and mercy of God. We pray too for governments whose duty it is to foster peace not violence, to promote harmony not discord.

Catholic communities across this country will reach out to the Muslim communities in their vicinity. We will work with Muslim leaders and all people of good will to combat hatred and violence in every form, to knock down walls and build bridges in the name of God who calls us to live as one family.

We join Pope Francis and the Grand Imam of Al-Azhar in speaking here "in the name of God who has created all human beings...to live together as brothers and sisters, to fill the earth and make known the values of goodness, love and peace; we speak "in the name of innocent human life that God has forbidden to kill, affirming that whoever kills a person is like one who kills the whole of humanity" (Abu Dhabi Declaration, 4 February 2019).

Pastoral/Stewardship Council Report Tuesday 5th March 2019

The Pastoral Council received an update on the Plenary Council and noted that the closing date for submissions was Ash Wednesday 6th March. The next phase will be to identify the main agenda items for the Council proper. It is expected that the first draft of these items will be available by the end of June.

We are fast running out of time to have all volunteers complete their paperwork for the Archdiocese to cover them in their various ministries. PLEASE ensure that YOU complete your paperwork and provide colour identification to the Parish Office ASAP.

Councillors were then given the opportunity to update the Council on their portfolios and the main discussion centred on

Community Involvement: - The Parish had another successful BBQ at Bunnings, thanks to the parishioners who turned out to support the day. It was noted that the World Day of Prayer was also attended by a number of our parishioners.

Social Justice: - A relationship with the Parish
St. Vincent De Paul conference has been
established to nourish and support the
great work the members carry out in
their community work. There is a need
for someone to work with the Parish
Council in the area of refugee support
so, if you are interested please let the
Parish Office know.

Children and Youth: - The Parish Facebook page will be updated and streamlined to appeal to the young people in our Parish. The Archdiocese Youth Coordinator has been approached for advice and assistance on how to better communicate and engage the youth in our Parish and work on this and other initiatives will continue.

Parish Celebrations: - Early days but preparatory planning for the next Multicultural Dinner has commenced. Other gatherings, including a get together for St. Patrick's Day after 5pm Mass on Monday 18th, will receive the appropriate attention as they arise.

Other issues raised and discussed included the need for a whole of Parish Master Plan to establish links between all the various aspects of Parish life including pastoral activities, assets, finances, projects and administration. A meeting will be convened with the Archdiocese to discuss the matters pertinent to these areas. This will enable Fr. Emmanuel and the Parish Council to have better access to all this information. This initiative will be pursued soon.
