

A Thought From Fr Emmanuel

THE HOLY SPIRIT IS THE SOUL OF THE CHURCH

The Catholic Church teaches that one receives **Seven Gits of the Holy Spirit** at Baptism and that they are strengthened at Confirmation, so that the person can proclaim the truths of the faith. "The reception of the sacrament of Confirmation is necessary for the completion of baptismal grace." For "by the sacrament of Confirmation, [the baptized] are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed" (*CCC 1285*).

The Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit

Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety and Fear of the Lord.

Twelve Fruits of the Holy Spirit

Charity, Joy, Peace, Patience, Benignity (kindness), Goodness, Longanimity (generosity), Mildness (gentleness), Faith, Modesty, Continency (self-control), and Chastity.

How we receive the Holy Spirit

Through the seven sacraments - The seven Sacraments of the Church are: Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Penance (also known as Confession or Reconciliation), the Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders and Matrimony, The Word of God (Bible) and the Liturgy of the Church.

Symbols of the Holy Spirit

Fire, the Wind, Water, the Cloud, Anointing with oil, the Seal and the Dove.

Prayer

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.

V. Send forth your Spirit, and they shall be created.

R. And You shall renew the face of the earth.

O, God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations. Through Christ Our Lord. Amen.


