

A Thought From Fr Emmanuel

Consecration of Families to the Sacred Heart

(May I encourage you to do this prayer on the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (26th June) and every first Friday of the Month)

O most Sacred Heart of Jesus, Thou didst reveal to the blessed Margaret Mary Thy desire to rule over Christian families; behold, in order to please Thee, we stand before Thee this day, to proclaim Thy full sovereignty over our family. We desire henceforth to live Thy life, we desire that the virtues, to which Thou hast promised peace on earth, may flower in the bosom of our family; we desire to keep far from us the spirit of the world, which Thou hast condemned. Thou art King of our hearts by our love of Thee alone, with which our hearts are on fire and whose flame we shall nourish by frequent reception of the Holy Eucharist.

Be pleased, O Sacred Heart, to preside over our gathering together, to bless our spiritual and temporal affairs, to ward off all annoyance from us, to bless our joys and comfort our sorrows. If any of us has ever been so unhappy as to fall into the misery of displeasing Thee, grant that he may remember, O Heart of Jesus, that Thou art full of goodness and mercy toward the repentant sinner. And when the hour of separation strikes and death enters our family circle, whether we go or whether we stay, we shall all bow meekly before Thine eternal decrees. This shall be our consolation, to remember that the day will come, when our entire family, once more united in heaven, shall be able to sing of Thy glory and Thy goodness forever.

May the immaculate Heart of Mary and the glorious Patriarch Saint Joseph grant to offer Thee this our act of consecration, and to keep the memory thereof alive in us all the days of our lives.

Glory to the Heart of Jesus, our King and our Father! Amen.

Parish Financial Position

Last weekend you were updated on the Parish financial position and budget for 2019. The main point for consideration was the shortfall of income below the basic costs to operate the Parish, an amount of around \$26,000.

You were asked to prayerfully discern your ability to contribute more to the Parish collections, preferably by being part of the Planned Giving Program and paying your commitment by Direct Debit, Direct Credit or Weekly Envelopes.

With Mass attendances of 400 per week the \$26,000 shortfall could be overcome by an additional contribution of \$1.25 per person per week or, perhaps, by an additional contribution of \$5 per family per week — figures worth pondering!!!!

The Parish urges you, therefore, to reflect on these figures and advise the Parish Office of either your willingness to join Planned Giving, your preferred method of contributing and the amount, or the variation you wish to make to your existing Planned Giving.



Plenary Council Update June 2019

In the latest Plenary Council News, the Archdiocese of Brisbane hosted a Parish Leadership Day and the day was devoted to updates on the Plenary Council in 2020. The current situation with the second stage of the process, the "Listening and Discernment" stage, is that the mountain of information received by the steering committee has been distilled into 6 National Themes, viz. Mission and Evangelisation; Inclusivity, Participatory and Synodal; Prayerful and Eucharistic; Humble, Healing and Merciful; Joyful, Hope-filled and Servant Community; and, finally, Open to conversion, renewal and reform. These themes were launched at the Day and are available for everyone to peruse at the Plenary website. I encourage you to have a look on www.plenarycouncil.org au

Safeguarding Children & Vulnerable Adults Policy




