A Thought From Fr Emmanuel

The Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel

The Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel is a feast day which is celebrated on July 16th. It is the feast on which the church celebrates the appearance of the Blessed Virgin Mary to Carmelite St. Simon Stock on July 16th, 1251.

Mount Carmel is a mountain range in Israel, close to the port city of Haifa, which is near where Christ lived as a child. Which has led many people to consider it a holy mountain. Even before it became home to the Carmelite monks who would eventually call it home during the 12th century. These monks were particularly devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary and regarded her as their patroness.

On July 16th, 1251 St. Simon Stock is said to have seen the Blessed Virgin Mary and that she had given him the Carmelite habit – the Brown Scapular. According to Carmelite tradition, anyone who wears the Brown scapular faithfully – while remaining faithful to the Virgin Mary – will be delivered early from Purgatory when they die.

In order to foster and facilitate relationship with God, through prayer and contemplation, Carmelite spirituality proposes certain means, both personal and communal, namely meditation on the word of God, liturgy, silence and solitude, and asceticism. St. John of the Cross, St. Teresa of Lisieux are some of the famous Carmelite saints.


St Vincent de Paul are in need of clean 500ml or 600ml plastic bottles. If you're able to assist, donations can be left at the Parish Office.




Are you New to Our Parish
