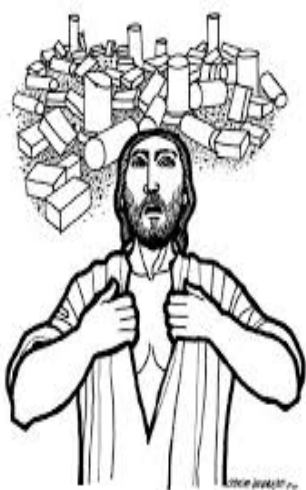

Weekly Reflection



Praying Hearts and Helping Hands

Dear Friends,

I would like to share with you a couple of excerpts from the Catholic Leader on the bushfire situation in the archdiocese of Brisbane and beyond.

EXHAUSTED fire crews battled flames in catastrophic conditions, as unprecedented bushfires claimed lives and livelihoods, and smoke shrouded east coast towns from Sydney to far north Queensland.

"All it takes is one spark to start a fire that may burn for days," Queensland Fire and Emergency Services acting commissioner Mike Wassing said, declaring a state of emergency on November 12. amid tinder-box conditions, unpredictable winds pushed firefronts towards communities with a speed and intensity that have shocked even the most hardened firefighters. More than 100 fires are burning across New South Wales and parts of Queensland. "Everyone should have a bushfire survival plan and know what they are going to do if a fire approaches," Mr Wassing said.

On one day last week, air quality in Brisbane was worse than Beijing – at an emergency level that can cause shortness of breath and aggravate heart conditions.

St Vincent de Paul Society Queensland launched [the Vinnies Bushfire Appeal](#) calling for cash donations to help victims through the unprecedented bushfire emergency.

Catholic parishes and priests are among those on alert and boosting emergency preparations. Across Brisbane archdiocese, 104 parishes were urged to have plans ready to secure churches, including removing valuable assets like baptismal records, chalices and vestments, and to move Mass if necessary.

"Very high to extreme fire danger ratings conditions have been experienced by parishes in the archdiocesan deaneries of North Country, North Coast, South Country, South Coast and Logan," a Work Health and Safety newsletter sent to parishes said. "Parishes should discuss and develop plans to conduct Mass and house the parish priest(s) away from bushfire danger areas in these circumstances." Remember the safety of people must come first.

Stories of Faith: Anonymous

I came close to God through crisis. In many ways I feel like the prodigal son. When my wife was diagnosed with cancer at [in her 20s] my understanding of my faith was changed forever. Two years into her journey, I had completely turned my back on God – why would a loving God allow my wife to die and be in so much pain? Why would he let her get cancer at precisely the time we were planning to have children? Why would my life be completely disrupted to become her carer – losing my job and moving away from friends and family? I did not understand God, or where He was in my life at all. But I did witness my wife completely surrender her life to Him. She knew she was going to die and that God would take her to Heaven when He was ready for her. Three-and-a-half years after the diagnosis, He did exactly that. And I then realised that God was helping me the whole time – He was working through me to care for her, to be God for her and to love her. I sacrificed everything to care for her, but God gave me the physical, emotional and mental strength to carry [my wife] through her difficult earthly pilgrimage.
