FEAST OF THE DEDICATION OF THE CATHEDRAL OF ST STEPHEN, BRISBANE Wednesday 4 December 2019



"The Cathedral of St Stephen's, in its various forms, has been part of the city of Brisbane from the very beginning. Its situation, right at the heart of the city, suggests its place in the story of Brisbane. What is now the chapel gave way to the larger church; and then there were dreams of a much grander cathedral which was never built. Funds from the sale of the property designated for the new cathedral was used for the remarkable renovation of St Stephen's thirty years ago, which led to the dedication.

The renovation was not just of the cathedral itself but of the entire precinct, which is something of which we can be proud. It is a gift we offer the city, an oasis at the heart of the CBD.

The cathedral is also a focal point for the Archdiocese, in a very real sense the mother church. That is why the feast of the dedication is celebrated not just in the cathedral but in all the churches of the Archdiocese. On this thirtieth anniversary I commend the feast to you in a special way, asking that you make it a moment when we pray for the unity of the People of God and a renewal of prayer and mission in the Church which makes her pilgrim way in this part of the world."

Each year, the dedication of the cathedral is celebrated as a solemnity in the cathedral itself and as a feast day in all the other churches of a diocese. In Brisbane, the anniversary falls on 4 December, this year on a Wednesday. It is 30 years since the Cathedral of St Stephen in Brisbane was refurbished and dedicated. Although it is an annual feast in the liturgical calendar, the 30th anniversary merits special attention throughout the diocese.

Celebrating the dedication of the cathedral is a way of marking the importance and dignity of the local Church. It celebrates our unity under the pastoral leadership of the bishop. It draws all communities into a common vision and the mission of the Gospel. This is why the bishop is named each time the Eucharistic Prayer is proclaimed: Be pleased to confirm in faith and charity your pilgrim Church on earth, with your servant Francis our Pope and Mark our Bishop... and the entire people you have gained for your own.

As a feast day, the Dedication of the Cathedral takes precedence over the Advent weekday and the optional commemoration of St John Damascene which also falls on 4 December. This means that white vestments are worn and it is celebrated with particular joy because it expresses who we are as the local Church.
