# ASH WEDNESDAY THOUGHTS

Dear friends,

We begin our journey to Easter beginning with Ash Wednesday. Authentic religion brings about inner transformation.

It is easier to give up chocolate than unkind words. It is easier to increase our devotions than our spirit of gratitude. It is easier to abstain from food than from bitterness.

I always found the following list of a different way of fasting very helpful and meaningful. It goes straight to the core of the Gospel: the renewal of our hearts and minds.

FAST from judging others; FEAST on the Christ within them. FAST from emphasis on differences; FEAST on the unity of life. FAST from apparent darkness; FEAST on the reality of light. FAST from thoughts of illness; FEAST on the healing power of God. FAST from words that pollute; FEAST on phrases that purify. FAST from discontent; FEAST on gratitude. FAST from anger; FEAST on patience. FAST from pessimism; FEAST on optimism. FAST from worry; FEAST on trust in God. FAST from complaining; FEAST on appreciation. FAST from negatives; FEAST on affirmatives. FAST from unrelenting pressures; FEAST on unceasing prayer. FEAST on non-resistance. FAST from hostility; FAST from bitterness; FEAST on forgiveness. FAST from self-centredness; FEAST on compassion for others. FEAST on eternal Truth. FAST from personal anxiety; FAST from discouragement; FEAST on hope. FAST from facts that depress; FEAST on verities that uplift. FAST from lethargy; FEAST on enthusiasm. FAST from suspicion; FEAST on truth. FAST from thoughts that weaken; FEAST on promises that inspire. FAST from shadows of sorrow; FEAST on the sunlight of serenity. FAST from idle gossip; FEAST on purposeful silence. FAST from problems that overwhelm; FEAST on prayer that under girds.
