A Message from Fr Emmanuel

The Lord is Truly Risen...Alleluia...!

In rising from the dead Jesus has conquered sin and death. His death and resurrection has inaugurated the new creation-the new heaven and the new earth.

Over the past few months' large areas of our land has been devastated with bush fires, torrential downfalls and flooding and now a pandemic. Fire, flood and pandemic are sharp reminders of our contingency. Death is the absolute certainty we have in this life. We are born, we grow, we die and in time we turn to dust. But the resurrection of Jesus is the guarantee of our own resurrection. Jesus assured Martha at the tomb of Lazarus: "I am the Resurrection and the life; whoever believes in Me will live even though he dies" (Jn 11:25-26).

Easter reminds us that every Good Friday in our lives will have an Easter Sunday, and so let us share the power of his Resurrection. Through his resurrection from the dead Jesus is making the whole of creation new. In that new creation sickness and death, pain and suffering, fires, floods and plague will all be things of the past. Nothing can destroy us — not pain, sin, rejection, betrayal or death — because Christ has conquered all these. We, too, can conquer them if we put our Faith and trust in Him. Alleluia ...Jesus is risen.

"May the Risen Lord be a living experience to you pervading every area of your life, blessing you, strengthening you, inspiring you, guiding you and supporting you."

Fr Emmanuel's Guidelines for Mass at Home

To our valued parishioners who do not have access to social media or Foxtel,

- 10 Play celebrates Sunday Mass for you at home at 6am each Sunday.
- On weekdays Fr Emmanuel celebrates Mass at 6pm followed by Rosary. He will be remembering all the
 parishioners in his Mass. Parishioners are encouraged to spiritually attend this service by spending one hour
 in prayer. (6pm 7pm). If we can be spiritually united and pray together from our own homes it will give us a
 great sense of unity and power.
- One hour prayer can be done by doing the following 5 steps:
 - 1. Sign of the Cross
- 2. Reading daily Mass readings 3. Pray the Our Father
- 4. Act of Spiritual Communion


My Jesus,




