A Message from Fr Emmanuel

Mass Updates

Dear Parishioners,

Holy Mass reminds us of God's love for us and Jesus's abiding presence in our midst. This wonderful Sacrament fills our hearts with faith, hope and love. Around the Eucharistic table of sharing we are reminded of the needs of others, to be hospitable and to serve in love.

Covid 19 has changed our life in general and our way of celebration of the Mass particular. However, in our parish we have never stopped the Mass but continued it safely and cautiously. I am glad to let you know that from next week onwards we are increasing the number of attendees to the maximum as much as each of our church can contain under the protocols. So, I would like to share with you the updated information of Mass attendance for your kind attention.

- 1. We will have 4 Masses on every weekend at regular timings at each church.
- 2. Abiding with the guideline 1.5 sq meter space between the people each church is measured. Accordingly, the maximum number of people each our church can hold is approximately 50.
- 3. The above number necessarily include the **Celebrant, Altar servants, Readers, Musicians, Sacristans, Marshalls, Collectors and people for camera and data.**
- 4. When you book in for Mass you will be asked whether you can do **any of the jobs in the church**. So please step up and offer your help.
- 5. The Marshall has the duty of asking you to follow the protocols. In case number people exceeds than what is permitted, Marshall has to say 'no' to those who come later. Please be considerate and cooperative.
- 6. The increase in number is a good thing but it involves also **great responsibility** from each of you. So, I earnestly request all the parishioners to responsibly consider the following:
- Please give your phone number when you book in for the Mass
- If you are **unwell, sick, have fever, cold or any other serious health concerns** please do not come for the Mass.
- Please sanitise your hands and sign in as you enter
- Be mindful of the social distancing
- Please cooperate with the **Marshall**.

In this week parish will install online booking facility through Eventbrite website : https://www.eventbrite.com.au/. You will know the details through facebook and the newsletter in the coming days.

These instructions are subject to change as the government guidelines change. However, you will be updated of the change when it happens.

We are always happy to have you in the church. Your support and cooperation makes our celebration really experiential and enriching. Let us together have a safe, secure and joyous journey together.

Sacramental Programs for Children in 2020

You will all be aware of the delays, caused by restrictions due to Covid 19, that have prevented us from progressing according to our Parish Calendar. I am happy to announce that we can soon get underway with some of our Sacraments, with the Baptism of Older Children taking place in late July. Parents of these children have already been informed. Unfortunately because of COVID 19, we will not be able to have huge numbers of family & friends attend the ceremonies, this year, and we ask for your cooperation in this regard.

EUCHARIST: In the week after schools return from School Holidays, the APREs from both our Catholic schools have offered to work closely with our Sacramental Co-ordinator (Marg) and they will provide the Catechesis during school time (July 24th & 31st between 2-3pm), for the children who attend our Parish Schools. This of course is to be repeated at home, with the parents as well. We thank them and the Principals for their generosity to ensure the shortest delay possible. In order for this to run smoothly, Parents are requested to notify Marg of their agreement to this. Following the completion of the catechesis, we will book children in at one of our Parish Masses to receive Eucharist, dependant on the number able to attend Mass at that time. Marg will contact the families of children who attend schools, outside our Parish.

CONFIRMATION: We are hopeful that we can stick (as much as possible) to our August timetable for the receipt of this sacrament, with our Dean: Fr. Emmanuel able to be our Celebrant, but the numbers will be limited to Child, parent/s, Sponsor/s. If you are able to help us that will be much appreciated, so that hopefully, all the children can share in the one weekend. We ask you to confirm with Marg, that you want your child to continue this year, because of the restricted numbers.

RECONCILIATION: We will organise as much as possible that this Sacrament will be celebrated during school hours. Dates will be confirmed, and parents notified.

We thank all the Parents, Principals & School teachers/APREs and everyone involved, in ensuring our children are able to celebrate the Sacraments this year. This is a big job in light of restrictions, and we thank them for their efforts. It is wonderful to see Parish, School and Parishioners working together. The children are the future of the Church!

Romans 15:5 May God, who gives this patience and encouragement, help you live in complete harmony with each other, as is fitting for followers of Christ Jesus.

- Despite the strange personalities many of us have, the Lord accepts us and will continue to do so.

We accept one another for the sake of the gospel and the fact that accepting one another gives God the glory! (verse 7)


