We read in the Acts of the Apostles the Holy Spirit filled apostles with his power and gave them the gift of tongues. As they received the gifts of the Spirit they started preaching about Jesus with deep faith and courage. They started performing great miracles and signs among the people. The Sprit totally and completely transformed them and they became new persons with a new vision and mission.

Pentecost was a day of wonders, miracles, newness, hope and a total re-creation. Under the canopy of the Holy Spirit, on this day, the church was born as a sign of hope and love, meaning and purpose for the world. Today the church needs a new Pentecost.



As we know the world is once again going through tough times the feast of Pentecost has great significance and meaning. Let us invoke the powerful intercession of the Holy Spirt to come down on the church and the world with another Pentecost.

In these days leading to Pentecost we celebrate Reconciliation Week. The Holy Spirit, we say, brings peace and joy. But the coming of non-Indigenous has brought our Indigenous peoples violence and sorrow, as we acknowledge on Sorry Day and in Reconciliation Week. Until the Indigenous of this land know peace and joy Australia will always have a running sore at its heart and never be the land it's called to be.

He is from Eritea/Ethiopa background. He speaks and reads English quite well. He has had support from The Redlands Council via a horticultural course and also has some land management expertise. He is getting uncomfortable with his current living arrangements and wishes to explore the possibility of obtaining alternative accommodation. He is fairly flexible about this, eg, shared house, lodger, granny flat or similar.
