Scripture Reflection

"Christ is with us at every moment of our lives"

This week's readings reveal a God with power. As God's creatures, the forces of nature listen to and obey the voice of their Creator. Though the storms of fear and doubt may have played more significant roles in our lives during this past year, God's love continues to speak to us with words of calm, as it did to Job (**First Reading**).



It is the love of Christ, not the storm, which 'overwhelms us' (**Second Reading**). This love is shown in the **Gospel**, when Jesus 'rebukes the wind' and the wind and waves obey. He is revealing something about his divine nature. 'Who can this be?' the disciples are led to ask as they are filled with awe. Their question may also be seeking a faith response in us as well.

Let's begin to ponder our own responses with the help of these scripture passages. Although we may yet be experiencing storms blowing around and within us, let's listen for that strong, yet calm voice, which brings with it peace and security. We may want to pray that the voice of the psalmist may echo throughout our lives in the coming week: 'Give thanks to the Lord, for his love endures forever'.

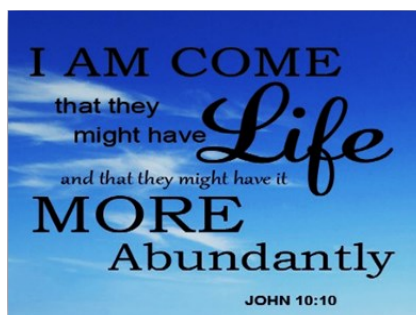

Penance for Older Children [Celebrating the First Rite of Reconciliation].



Christian Initiation [Baptism, Confirmation and First Communion] incorporates us into God's People.

Introducing children to the greatness of God's mercy in the Sacrament of Penance is a two-step process:

- ✘ A simple celebration of the rite of the Sacrament of Penance is included as a part of the preparation for First Communion.
- ✘ In the year when the children turn ten (**Year Five**), they are prepared to celebrate more fully the Sacrament of Penance with individual confession and absolution (the first rite).
- ✘ This builds on the work of the previous year, as they take the second step and learn in greater detail what it means to examine their conscience.
- ✘ It is a collaborative process: parish-based, family-centred and school-supported.
- ✘ **Parent's Information Session: Wednesday 14th July, 7.00 pm in St Anthony's Church.**
- ✘ **Children's Sessions: 4 Wednesdays in July/August. Date and Times TBC**

You prepare them for life. To teach them how to be loving, within your family to begin with, sharing and learning to say sorry.</p> <p>The Church takes this responsibility very seriously, and therefore works to assist you in this important area of formation for their life ahead. You already make sure they are fed, sheltered, healthy, and be-have in a loving, caring way.</p> <p>Spirituality is also one of the basic needs of human life. As a parent, you also have the responsibility to form your child's spirituality so that they may grow in faith and be caring as an adult. Perhaps, you may take this for granted, but if you reflect back, your parents have done this for you, throughout your younger years, though you may not have noticed, or even rebelled against it as teenagers. Now it's your turn!</p> <p>We are here to support you in this task of forming spirit-filled human beings for the future. How?</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. You may register your child at any time from July onwards, each year, for the following year. 2. Each child receives a Mass Card to be signed by the priest when you are able to take your child to any of our 4 Masses. [4.30 pm Sat & 9.00 am Sunday at Anthony's and 6.00 pm Sat & 7.00 am Sun at ST Luke's]. We recommend, to begin with, you attend every couple of weeks to fit in with your family activities. A child's comfort and participation in Mass regularly will help us discern his/her readiness to receive the Sacraments in the following year. 3. In October each year, we will have information sessions for you, the parents. It is essential for you to attend one of these sessions in order for you to have enough information to plan ahead for the next year. 4. At the beginning of each year, we discern with you and your child, his/her readiness to be en-rolled in the Formation program for Baptism, Confirmation, First Communion or Penance for old-er children. 5. Once Enrolled, your child must then attend the relative sessions/workshops as planned in order for your child to celebrate the Sacraments in the first half of the year. <p>If you have any questions please contact Trish, Pastoral Associate.
