

Scripture Reflection

'You must do what the Word tells you'

We ask with confidence that the Lord show us the path that will draw us ever closer to his presence.



Our readings this week encourage us to pay

attention to the ways in which the word of God truly influences how we live our lives. Although we all too often fail to live up to the example set for us, we are none the less assured of an abundance of gifts, because of God's infinite love for each and everyone.

In the **First Reading**, Moses explains to the people that it is by obeying the laws given to them in the commandments that they will have life in the land, as promised to them by the Lord. The importance of actively living our faith is further emphasised in the **Second Reading**. Here the author exhorts Jewish Christians not just to listen to the word, but to do what the word tells them, by caring for those in need, and living good and honest lives.

In the **Gospel**, Jesus describes the lip-service of the Pharisees, who, as foretold in the words of Isaiah, offer 'worthless worship'. Their adherence to human traditions and values takes their hearts far from God.

This week, we may want to spend some time reflecting, with the Lord's help, how closely our own lives reflect the ideals described in the Psalm, which speaks of the just dwelling in the presence of the Lord. We can then ask with confidence that the Lord will show us the path that will draw us ever closer to his presence.

Reconciliation (officially called the Sacrament of Penance, and also known as Confession) is a Sacrament instituted by Jesus Christ in his love and mercy to offer us forgiveness for the times we have sinned and turned away from God.

At the same time, we are reconciled with the Church because it is also wounded by our sins.

Every time we sin, we hurt ourselves, other people and God.

In Reconciliation, we acknowledge our sins before God and the Church.

We express our sorrow in a meaningful way, receive the forgiveness of Christ

and his Church, make reparation for what we have done, and resolve to do better in the future.

New Parish Sacramental Policy 2022

CICCA [Christian Initiation of Children of Catechetical Age]









Our formation and preparation for our parish children in our Primary schools, Catholic or State Schools, is based on the principles outlined in our mission statement: that the whole journey is guided by the Holy Spirit, that we are mindfully inclusive of all who come, called and named by God. We understand that the ultimate step in full initiation, is through celebrating and living out Eucharist, for the rest of our lives, as disciples of Jesus Christ.

Children learn best by watching and seeing, and then copying what they see. What do we as a community want them to see and learn? Our Mission statement gives us pause for thought and assists us in answering that question. **The children in our Parish/School community will walk a journey that is based on our Catholic Christian practice with community support and involvement.** We will be relying on our gathered community to welcome and support the children and the mums and dads as they begin or continue the Parish Sacramental Journey.

Each step is discerned between parents, children and the Parish Leadership as to when is the right time for each family to participate. Children baptised as infants begin the journey at Preparing for Confirmation. The Parish offers preparation and catechesis through: **1.Baptism for Older Children**; **2. Confirmation [including the second rite of Reconciliation]**; **3. First Communion**; **4 Penance for Older Children**. We expect that children preparing for Confirmation and First Communion will be from 7 years of age or older and children preparing for the First Rite of Reconciliation will be 10 years or older.

October 2021: Parents Information Sessions for ALL Sacraments in 2022

two Masses per month.]

Term 1, 2022: Confirmation: Parents' Information & Children's Preparation Sessions

Term 2, 2022: First Communion: Parents' Information & Children's Preparation

Sessions [including Family celebration of 2nd Rite of Celebration]

Term 3, 2022: Penance for Older Children: Parents' Information & Children's Preparation Sessions.

Term 4, 2022: Baptism for Older Children: Parents' Information & Children's Preparation Sessions.

October 2022: Parents Information Sessions for ALL Sacraments in 2023
