#### REQUESTS FOR EXEMPTIONS FROM COVID-19 VACCINATION ON RELIGIOUS GROUNDS

Recently I have been hearing of priests being asked to endorse a religious exemption for the COVID-19 vaccine. The Archdiocese of Brisbane follows Pope Francis's lead in supporting vaccination for all except those with a valid medical exemption.

For Catholics, there is no legitimate reason to seek an exemption on religious grounds. In summary, clergy in this archdiocese cannot endorse an exemption on religious grounds for the Covid19 vaccine.

The Archdiocese of Brisbane supports COVID-19 vaccination except for those people with a valid medical exemption from their health professional. We do recognise that some Catholics have concerns about the origins of the cell-line associated with the development of the AstraZeneca vaccine. If this is a concern for you then the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines provide two alternatives that avoid this issue.
