## Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord



Many of us would remember that this Sunday was *called Palm Sunday.* Since 2010 we now know it as Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord because it is not only about the Palms and the Procession but concludes Lent and draws us into Holy week. There are two differences to the normal Sunday Mass. First we begin with the Commemoration of the Lord's

entrance into Jerusalem. This may take three different forms according to time, place and local circumstances.

The second difference is that we proclaim the Passion of Christ. Usually three or more people assist in the proclaiming of the Passion Gospel. It is proclaimed without candles, incense, greeting, signs of the cross, or final acclamation. The Homily immediately follows.

#### Why do we have Silence during Mass?

In our very busy lives, it is often that we arrive at Mass with adrenalin pumping. Even Mass can be busy with singing, standing, sitting to name a few. However, you will notice that there are times of silence during Mass. Treat this time as a gift to you. These short moments are not because someone has forgotten to do something, or the priest fell asleep, but rather small gifts to pause take a breath and take in what you have just heard, or prepare you for what is to come. If you realise, in these short moments of silence, that you cannot remember one word of what was proclaimed two breaths ago, perhaps you can ask the Holy Spirit to help you in listening to the next section of the Mass. What is one word or sentence you can take with you when you go back into the hurly-burly of daily life. Enjoy the silence of the Spirit!


