

# Marriage Advice from The Marriage Course

It's a common misconception that relationships breakdown because of big things, but in truth it's the small 'cracks' left unresolved over time that can to do much more damage. And no relationship is immune from this! Thankfully, there are two simple but profound words that can mend hurt and restore unity - 'I'm sorry' and 'I forgive you'. The hard part is that we may need to say 'sorry' and 'I forgive you' again and again, often for the same thing! But it's worth it. Being committed to reconciliation as couples helps us restore the cracks that we cause and build relationships that are strong and enduring.
