
What's on in the community



Dear Parishioners and visitors.

God created the world with all its wonders! Humanity was formed in God's own image and likeness which is God's masterpiece. God entrusted the world to humanity, to look after, to protect and care, as faithful stewards. We are not absolute owners of our possessions; everything belongs to God as the real owner. We are only stewards and we are invited to look after everything with a mindset of God, which is not that easy always. In today's world many times different stewards are under scanner. Slogans to protect nature, heart breaking cry from the war-torn lands, even cold war between different persons of the same blood and family - all are situations where we hear the question, are you a good, faithful steward?

In the parable the manager of the property of a wealthy man faces destitution because of his imminent dismissal. In this crisis the manager acts with foresight and resolution, ensuring a secure future. He responds with smartness to his circumstances and so in a sense is a "prudent" man.

Using the image of wealth and stewardship, Jesus calls us to reflect on a "wealth" of an entirely different nature than a monetary one. We are to focus on a type of stewardship with which we have been entrusted in this life, care for the gifts given us by God. The gift of our beautiful nature, the gift of our community and family, the gift of our own very life. The Christian teachings, are always based on love of the other which enables us to accept, protect and support.

We always hear about the issues of pollution, water, loss of biodiversity, decline in the quality of human life, global warming. 'laudato si',(praise be to you) with a sub title 'on care for our common home' is an encyclical letter on ecology and climate by pope Francis, and it says the principle of the maximization of profits, frequently isolated from other considerations, reflects a misunderstanding. (C5/195).

When we set aside the common good and the good of others, we tend to focus on our possessions than life. It can be the beginning to see others as threats, even our dear ones, which will create division in our relationships with God, our family, friends, and nature. We thank God for entrusting us with the divine responsibility to care and protect. The Christian vigilance leads us to the Christian detachment, which does not take away the value of earthly realities, but keeps us aware that there is more to come. The attraction of our meditation is not dishonesty and bad faith of the steward. We learn from the decisiveness, resourcefulness, and prudence of the steward when faced with realities of life.

Let us pray that we, the children of light be as decisive and prudent in securing our future, by laying up treasures in heaven.
