

Dear Parishioners and visitors,

Blessed virgin Mary has a special place in the heart of the Catholics, as a heavenly mother and an example. We do not worship Mary but we pray with Mary and seek her intercession when we pray the Rosary. The Rosary is a Scripture-based prayer. It begins with the *Creed*, which summarizes the great mysteries of the Catholic faith. The *Our Father*, which introduces each mystery, is from the Gospels. The first part of the *Hail Mary* is the angel's words announcing Christ's birth and Elizabeth's greeting to Mary. St. Pius V officially added the second part of the *Hail Mary*. The Mysteries of the Rosary centre on the events of Christ's life. There are four sets of Mysteries: Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious and, added by Saint John Paul II in 2002, the Luminous. The Rosary can be said privately or with a group. The repetition of the prayers in the Rosary is meant to lead us to restful and contemplative prayer related to each mystery. The **Joyful Mysteries** are traditionally prayed on Mondays, Saturdays, and, during the season of Advent, on Sundays: The Annunciation, 2. The Visitation, 3. The Nativity, 4. The Presentation in the Temple, 5. The Finding in the Temple. The **Sorrowful Mysteries** are traditionally prayed on Tuesdays, Fridays, and, during the season of Lent, on Sundays: The Agony in the Garden, 2. The Scourging at the Pillar, 3. The Crowning with Thorns, 4. The Carrying of the Cross, 5. The Crucifixion and Death.

The **Glorious Mysteries** are traditionally prayed on Wednesdays and, outside the seasons of Advent and Lent, on Sundays: The Resurrection, 2. The Ascension, 3. The Descent of the Holy Spirit, 4. The Assumption, 5. The Coronation of Mary.

The **Luminous Mysteries** are traditionally prayed on Thursdays: The Baptism of Christ in the Jordan, 2. The Wedding Feast at Cana, 3. Jesus' Proclamation of the Coming of the Kingdom of God, 4. The Transfiguration, 5. The Institution of the Eucharist.

How to pray the Rosary?

Begin with the Sign of the Cross.

Say the *Creed*.

On the first bead, say an *Our Father*.

Say one *Hail Mary* on each of the next three beads.

Say the *Glory Be*

For each of the five decades, announce the Mystery, then say the *Our Father*.

While fingering each of the ten beads of the decade, next say ten *Hail Marys* while meditating on the Mystery. Then say a *Glory Be*.

(After finishing each decade, we say the following prayer requested by the Blessed Virgin Mary at Fatima: *O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who have most need of your mercy.*)

After saying the five decades, say the *Hail, Holy Queen*, followed by concluding prayer. In the month of October, we pray the rosary in our parish, specially before each mass. I invite all of you to join for the Rosary and let us journey to God with Mary.
