

Many of the happenings in society challenge our ideals and convictions. People who really believe in God may ask, what are we to do to live according to our faith and conscience? We hear sometimes people say



"this world has been always like this and it is not going to change, we can only put up with it." Sometimes we become beneficiaries of corruption and injustice knowingly or unknowingly.

The true believers in the values of Christ, will be definitely disturbed when they witness injustice in social life and when they feel the pain of the innocent who suffers. Prophet Habakkuk went through this intense moral anguish, when he cried out: "Look, violence." He felt the overpowering presence of evil and its oppressive deeds. He wished, perhaps, not to see them and not to be disturbed by them. Prophet Habakkuk complains to God: "Why do you make me see wrongs and look upon trouble? Destruction and violence are before me; strife and contention arise."

He had to see in front of him all the wrongdoings of the world, with deep concern and pain. But he is assured by God that nothing will go unnoticed, he has only to wait faithfully for God's intervention for justice.

How can we live meaningfully and faithfully in today's world? St. Paul in his letter to Timothy gives a very enlightening and encouraging message: "God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power and of love and of self-control." This awareness is the wellspring of our moral courage. Drawing from this inner source St. Paul would confront every crisis and every suffering of his life with great confidence. He would say "I am not ashamed, for I know in whom I have my faith."

"Only faith in Christ can explain the mystery of life which we experience as contrasts and crosses in life and death, joy and suffering, good and evil. Faith strengthens us to face them with hope and courage. Faith is often misunderstood as an experience of irrationality before unknowable and unexplainable phenomena. Sometimes it is considered as a leap into darkness, into uncertainty. But faith is not risking of life nor is it an expression of blind ignorance. It is knowledge, an experience of wisdom and insight which emanates from the face of Christ". That is why faith is described as "light" in the encyclical of Pope Francis, *Lumen Fidei*.

The question is not how much faith we have but, rather, how are we living the faith that we do have.

The mustard seed of faith is already planted within us at baptism. It is Christ himself. Do we need more faith or Do we need more response to the faith?
