29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Parishioners and visitors,

The Amalekites were fierce fighters and every
nation of the Middle East was afraid of them.
No nation could withstand them. Israel could
not defeat them, at least not alone. But with
Moses' hands raised in prayer to the God of
Israel, with Aaron and Hur holding Moses'



hands up high in the ancient posture of prayer, not only was Amalek defeated, this
fierce nation was totally destroyed and by Jesus' time, Amalek was merely a
memory from the past. Fighting is not our point of reflection today but the power
of prayer and the need of persistence in prayer. There is nothing impossible with
God.

We are all people of prayer, who follow our own personal ways of prayer life as
well as use the written forms of prayer that other people found so powerful. Jesus
himself taught us to pray, approaching God, with a strong personal relationship.
But there is always a temptation to turn back from prayer life where people com-
plain that "the prayer is not answered or it takes too long".

Prayer in fact is a way of life that we are encouraged to embrace. It is a life where
we find the friendship of God accompanying us all through our journey. It is not a
question of shopping list being delivered to the door step. True prayer is a conver-
sation from heart to God, without the expectation of a red-carpet in life. Prayer
does not change the circumstances but changes us. It helps us to find God's will in
our daily life. When we pray we are not searching for answers in google. God has a
unique plan for each of us which is for the good of the individuals, others and for
the whole world.

The Gospel reminds us not to give up even when we are stuck with realities in life.
Some of us may have a real problem with our temper. We have tried every dynam-
ic known to get out of situations where we normally explode. And we have been
successful for the last few months. And then someone who knows us a bit too well
pushes the wrong button and we are lost. Sometimes it may be fighting an addic-
tion or problems in the home. One fails a course in school. Another one breaks up
with girlfriend or boyfriend or marriage is falling apart. One of the parents is sick.
So some people may figure it as an extreme situation. But we have the choice: trust
in God and start over, or give up. It is easy to give up. Don't ever give up. God can
help us to resume the fight. Keep our hands up. The duty of the Parish community
is to pray for those who are excluded and marginalized, and to help their hands up
in prayer, to overcome the darkness in their life. We can't give up on God, we can't
give up on ourselves. Let us trust in God, continue to pray and do our best.
