Perhaps some of you have been blessed to be able to travel to Rome and go to the Basilica of St. Peter. It is amazing. That is how the disciples felt when they looked at the Jerusalem Temple. The Temple that Solomon built, was destroyed by the Babylonians at the beginning of the captivity in 588 BC. In the year 26 B.C. Herod decided to restore the Temple to the Glory of Solomon's Day. The work on the Temple had just been completed when Jesus's disciples looked and amazed at the precious stones and votive offerings. Then Jesus said to them, "It really does not matter. It is all going to come to a ruin anyway." In fact, within forty years the Romans would put down the Jewish revolt, and, to break the spirit of the zealot rebels, would completely destroy the temple leaving nothing but what we now call the Wailing Wall still standing. Jesus foretold that the Temple would be demolished. He then goes on to say that the whole world will be destroyed. But Jesus desires that we are not to get confused. These are the feelings of those who refuse to commit their lives to the Kingdom of God. What we need to do is to give witness to Christ, particularly in the face of persecution. When Jesus spoke about persecution, He pointed His words to all of us who fight for traditional family values and responsibility against those that deify self-gratification. But patient endurance will save lives. The Temple that was built in Jerusalem might be destroyed, but the Temple that is the Life of Christ within us will never be destroyed. God bestows the needed grace and wisdom to face trials and to respond to the challenges to our faith. Our faithfulness to Christ doesn't mean sidestepping spiritual conflict, persecution, suffering and difficulties. Rather, belonging to Christ enables us to face trials with greater courage and love. It is always important to remember that the burdens of life don't disappear when we belong to Christ, but they do become bearable, because another is at our side, who is really stronger than us. If this is so, and we believe it is for all who follow Christ, then we should not fear or run away from whatever we experience as a challenge in life. Only with God's help can we do so, filled with joy and confidence that makes us bold witnesses of God's saving message of freedom and salvation in the Lord. Our God comes to rule the world with righteousness, be not afraid to let God act in the depths of our being today and</p>
