In 1966 *Time* Magazine published a cover story that asked, "Is God Dead?" This article suggested that the people no longer needed God, therefore, he is dead. This was a repetition of what the 19th century philosopher, Friedrich Nietzsche, said in his book '*Thus Spoke Zarathustra*'. Those who claimed that God was dead did so because they didn't

need him or God was no longer relevant to them. They thought that the world was very well in control without having to be concerned with the presence of God.

In our modern world, few people will say that God is dead, but many people act as though God is dead. When people think that they don't need God in their lives, when they assume, they have everything under control they put God to death. Then the freedom of religion is being reduced to freedom from religion.

When we push God aside from our life partially or fully, we are also joining those who crucified Jesus, who thought that they put an end to God's intervention in their lives. The death of Jesus was not the end of God, but the beginning of the new way of life in God. A new life of freedom from the bondage of failures and it's darkness. The celebration of *The* solemnity of *Jesus Christ the king of the universe*, invites us to reaffirm our choice. In complete freedom of heart, one may opt for God and life or choose the selfishness and shadow of death. This selection changes everything, the way we think, speak, do things, our entire life.

Let us learn from this great king who is our model, example and our way of life. Jesus is not a king who imposes, rather He invites. He is not a king who issues directives from afar; rather He speaks from within our heart and soul. Jesus is not an imperial king; rather he is a shepherd king. He is not a king filled with anger and wrath; rather He has a heart filled with compassion and mercy. He helps us to take responsibility for our own failures; than accusing others through hate speech. He teaches how we can be Kings without force and fighting, without hatred and competition. We celebrate and joyfully share the splendour of having Jesus as our King. God's rule of love transforms failures into grace, death into resurrection, fear into trust. We do need God. We help the world to know that Jesus is our King. We need to proclaim to others with our lives, "Jesus is your king king of Love rule too." our


