Dear Parishioners and visitors,

Once again we begin the season of **LENT** from this **ASH WEDNESDAY**. We have two masses across our parish churches, at which the cruciform smudge of ash will be signed on our foreheads according to our tradition. This ash will identify us as followers of Christ, as people committed to living and dying and rising with Christ.

May this Lenten journey be full of mercy, compassion and love, as it is our hearts, what is hidden, that the God will see and reward.


