

Dear Parishioners and visitors,

We just had a wonderful celebration of 'women's day' last day and the Gospel of John narrates the story of another woman whom Jesus meets at Jacob's well.



The long-winding conversation begins with a request on the part of Jesus for some water to drink. It progresses when she herself requests Jesus for the water, which can still one's thirst forever.

Jesus at the well is in the same condition of all living beings searching for water to quench their thirst. It is evident that this woman has not yet found true happiness and peace in her life. All her previous attempts were failures. She could not have stable relationships. She still searched for a meaningful life.

It was as if Jesus held for her a mirror, in which her true image was reflected. Jesus acts as true spiritual guide who leads the person to self-awareness, rather than impressing the person with spiritual ideas and counsels.

Jesus is the true source of happiness, fulfilment and life. One has to reach out to the source. Sometimes the wellsprings of life within is stopped by the garbage of the past experiences. Sometimes evil deeds, words, thoughts and their sediments pollute the source. Wounded feelings, bitterness, hatred and unforgiven moments, shared history can also choke the springs of life within a person.

It is in meeting with Jesus and, at the same time, meeting with others in his name that we discover more sources of life-giving water within us. They can be refreshing not only to us but also to others.

It is time to tell our story to Jesus like the Samaritan woman. Then only we can rejoice with her and the entire community saying: I have found the Messiah.


