Dear Parishioners and visitors,

Why all these vineyards? Three weeks in a row, our Sunday gospels have been about vineyards. Two weeks ago, we had the Parable of the Labourers in the Marketplace and the Good Employer who treated the workers as equal when he paid their wages. Last week we had the parable of the two sons who

were called to work in their father's vineyard. This week we have another vineyard story, of the wicked tenants who tried to take ownership of the vineyard, in an unlawful and unjust way.

The Lord's vineyard is the house of his people. Who are these wicked labourers? Jesus speaks about the people who were entrusted with the Vineyard of the Lord. They were given the mission to nourish the people in the Word of God and prepare them for the Word become Flesh. However, they failed to prepare the people for the coming of the Messiah. In fact, they did not even want a Messiah.

"So," the Lord says, "the vineyard will be taken from those evil tenants and given to others who would nurture it and bear the fruit of the Kingdom." We are given the deep responsibility to produce the fruits of the kingdom, compassion and forgiveness, mercy and love.

We gather for the celebration of the self-giving of the Son of God. The true spirit of Mass is self-denial and self-sacrifice. Using the environment or church for selfish gain is not the reason why we pray or come together to celebrate Mass. The Mass is the sending ceremony, like the messengers. At the mass we receive God's grace in word and sacrament so we can bring the Lord's presence to the people of the world, who long for God.

We come to Mass and share the grace we receive here to lead the children, spouses, and yes even our parents to the life of joy and peace in Jesus Christ. We do this, first of all, by growing closer and closer to the Lord so that our words and actions naturally reflect His Presence. We do this by standing up for all that is right and moral and by being kind to others. We do this by making the right choice, sometimes 'YES', sometimes 'NO'.

This parable richly conveys some important truths about God and the way he deals with his people. First, it tells us of God's generosity and trust. Like the owner, God trusts us enough to give us freedom to run life as we choose. This parable also tells us of God's patience and justice. Not once, but many times he forgives the tenants and gave another chance. But while the tenants take advantage of the owner's patience, his judgment and justice prevail in the end.
