Parish Churches 15 October 2023

Dear Parishioners and visitors,

People generally like get-togethers and parties. The Gospel presents a banquet where the invited don't show up. Today's readings are about God's invitation to us for the party.

The Prophet Isaiah tells us that God will provide a banquet for all peoples. Everyone is invited. God wants all to be saved. All will rejoice that God has saved us. This is a strong message because so many in our world do not want salvation for everyone nor even do many people want good things for everyone. The Gospel of Saint Matthew brings us back to banquets! The story has two parts. The first half is about a king who prepared a grand party to celebrate his son's wedding. The second half is about a person who entered the reception hall without wearing the proper wedding garment. Both parables end in tragedy. Why? What went wrong? Answer to this question is the answer of Jesus to all the problems and miseries we experience in our world. In the first parable, it was their king who invited them to the wedding feast of his son. But the invitees were busy with their own private business. Everything that we managed to get hold of should find its place and relevance in the totality. If we are not ready, the reward will be given to those who are ready. The second parable talks about the custom. At the foyer the invited guests were offered the wedding garments to be worn during the dinner. Everybody collected theirs and went in. But there was one person, even though he received a free invitation and was offered free wedding garments to be worn during the ceremony, he decided to disregard it. He wanted to enjoy the free lunch but was not ready to fulfil its requirements. The man who came without the proper clothes is the Christian in name only, who refuses to put on Jesus Christ throughout the life. This is the person who accepts the invitation of the Lord, but refuses to exercise his or her personal responsibility in the Christian community. An attitude or a mind-set of carelessness, laziness and rebellion and that may end up in a total separation from joy, protection and love. We are all invited to the feast that our God has prepared for us. That is what we commemorate when we celebrate the Holy Eucharist. Communities and families collapse when some members pursue only their part, forgetting their common business, the common good. Each day is a day to choose. God will not force us against our own choices. Jesus accepts our freedom even to reject Him and His invitation to the banquet of the Kingdom. So, we are left in the end with our own choice, but may we truly put on Christ, first in our homes, among God's people, and in our world.


