Jesus begins with calling to repentance. Repent in this setting is not just a call for some 'terrible sinners' but a call which means to change the direction of one's life. And we see with clarity where Jesus is pointing us: Believe in the Gospel! We have Jonah preaching repentance in the city of Nineveh. The preaching of Jonah was completely successful and the whole city repented including the rulers. Although Jonah did not want the city to repent but rather wanted it destroyed, we see that the people respond to Jonah's preaching and God's protection and love is experienced by them once again. God's only intention is our salvation and our good. Whenever God is presented as angry father in the Scriptures, it is because God loves us and the hope is that God's anger will bring us to repentance and then God's compassion is experienced by the people. The Gospel invites us to repent and believe in the Good News. And what is the Good News? How often we hear the Good News? It is that happiness and peace that we will enjoy if we are willing to turn to the Lord. The Good News is that nothing can take Christ away from us. No one, no situation in life, nothing can destroy the joy that we have in being united to the Lord. It is the experience of sharing in the life of Christ. It is believing that God loves us and sends His Son for our salvation! It's not enough to avoid evil, but we have to do good. We all need what God can offer us, in changing our own lives, which is perhaps the most difficult of all of the challenges we face. Once we respond positively to the invitation of God, we are already enjoying the fruits of repentance, which is ultimate joy and freedom. The first disciples truly enjoyed it in its fullness as far as they stayed closer to Jesus. It is a challenge to change our attitude towards God and other people. Once we get closer and know more, our attitudes will get changed. Change in our attitude will help us to accept God and life in a better way. The end result of change in attitude is always the true achievement. Let us pray for the 'Conversion of life', that is an ongoing requirement, if we are to share in the life of Christ.
