Weekly Reflection

Australia Day 2020 – A Day of Gratitude, Hope and Response

On Australia day, we thank God for his gifts to our land and to our people. We are blessed with rich traditions of peace, justice and truth for which we all aspire. Australia Day above and all a day of thanks giving to God and a day of hope for the future, that God's plan that all will be saved and live in peace will be fulfilled.

Australians who have come from many countries of origin rejoice in the freedom, the spaciousness, the tolerance, and the peace of our country. We rejoice in the huge material resources, which we have and these can tend to be all embracing and captivating.
