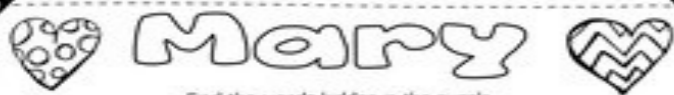

World's oldest man

In an article published on May 17 on the Guinness World Records website, 113-year-old Mr Mora said his secret to living a long life is to "work hard, rest on holidays, go to bed early, drink a glass of aguardiente (a strong liquor made from sugarcane) every day, love God, and always carry him in your heart".

He said his family and friends are his greatest life companions and that the greatest thing he has learned in life is "the love of God, the love of family, and that we must get up early to work".

According to the Guinness World Records, Mr Mora was officially confirmed the oldest living man in the world on February 4. *(FULL STORY: CNA)*

The Most Holy Trinity

Dear Parishioners and visitors,
St Thomas Aquinas said "it was much easier to say what God was not than what God is." So, when it comes to Trinity: three "Persons" in one God, we are researching into an area where ordinary human language is totally inadequate to express the reality.



The doctrine of Trinity tells us, that our God is a God of relationships; Who is not an isolated God who has no attribute of relating to others, we have a God who constantly looks forward to having people around. God does not want us to see Him as a figure up there who hasn't anything to do with us.

Jesus taught us and we have the privilege to address Him in a familiar and intimate term *Abba - father*. He is a father who cares, the one who waits for the Prodigal child to return and forgives completely, unconditionally and immediately. He is the Father of love, truth and compassion.

God emptied himself, took flesh and dwelt among us. He is God the Son. In the Son as a human being, we can see, hear and touch God. We see something of the nature of our God as Jesus heals the sick, identifies with the weak and socializes with the poor and the sinful. Wherever there is genuine love, there, is the Spirit of God at work. The Spirit leads us to do good and live in harmony. God the Father in Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit helps us to profess one faith, one love and one baptism.

We are to be people of relationship, always in need of each other, always there for each other. After all, faith without relationships are meaningless! May the Trinitarian family help us in our earthly journey, to stay united to God and God's creation.

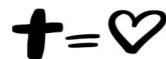
